

2010 Mentoring Corporate Honor Roll

Companies meeting at least three of the following criteria will be selected for membership in the Corporate Honor Roll:

- The CEO formally commits to involve his/her company in youth mentoring.
- The CEO and/or at least one member of the senior management is a mentor.
- The company has established a policy regarding employee release time for mentoring
- The company has designated an employee who oversees internal coordination of the program
- The company has formed a mentoring alliance with a school, school district or community-based organization, which focuses on academic success, self-esteem, character development, school-to-career and/or workforce development.
- At least 10 employees or 1% of the company workforce, (whichever is larger) are involved in mentoring

Mentoring is defined as a relationship that lasts at least six months between a caring individual and a young person formed with the purpose of providing the young person with guidance and support.

The Mentoring Corporate Honor Roll recognizes and pays tribute to those businesses whose leadership and involvement have significantly advanced youth mentoring in Connecticut.
